Waterfowl Hunting

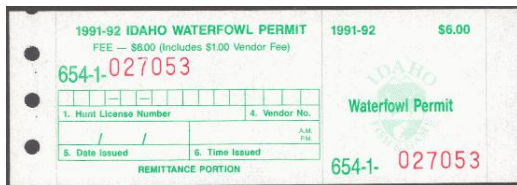
Migratory Waterfowl Stamp (ID-W)

Stamps are multicolored, have black serial numbers and were issued in two formats: sheet stamps perforated on 4 sides and hunter stamps in booklets with 2-part tabs and straight edges on 3 sides. A self-adhesive provisional stamp with tab and red serial numbers was issued in 1991. From 1996 on, only collector stamps were issued that were not valid for hunting.

Hunter Migratory Waterfowl Stamp (ID-WH)

Hunter stamps were printed in booklets with an information tab and selvage at the left. Black serial numbers were printed on both the stamp and the tab. Stamp images are identical to the sheet stamp of the same year. All hunter stamps have at least one straight edge. Prices are for stamps with tabs.

Upland Game Permit (ID-UB)

Stamps are multicolored, have black serial numbers and were issued in two formats: sheet stamps perforated on 4 sides and hunter stamps in booklets with 2-part tabs and straight edges on 3 sides. A self-adhesive provisional stamp with tab and red serial numbers was issued in 1991. From 1996 on, only collector stamps were issued that were not valid for hunting.
